Job Description

The Youth Ministry Intern will:

- † Help with programming for all youth activities
- † Help plan and implement Sunday night programs, and weekly bible studies
- † Carry out administration & outreach tasks (e-mails, mailouts, phone calls, etc.)
- † Challenge youth to higher levels of discipleship
- † Assist the Youth Director in carrying out the vision of our youth ministry program.
- † Be held accountable to their duties by the Youth Director
- † Submit to a criminal background check and drug screening

The Youth Ministry Intern will be someone who:

- † Has been out of high school for at least two years
- † Has a committed relationship to Jesus Christ and is committed to live and model the Christian life.
- † Has a passion for teenagers and is available to their needs
- † Is self-motivated
- † Demonstrates a desire to grow spiritually and professionally

The Youth Ministry Intern work schedule includes:

- † Be in attendance on both Sunday mornings and Sunday evenings.
- † Participate in a weekly youth bible study as a leader.
- † Internship is a 20 hour a week, part-time salaried position.
- † The Intern will work most Sunday evenings from 3:30-8:30 pm, with additional 15 hours to be arranged on a weekly basis.
- † Additional hours will be necessary for special events and retreats. During these weeks hours will be extended to accommodate the event, but these hours will not be made up in comp time.
- † Intern will be expected to accompany youth on extended trips that will be overnight events. During these events salary will remain the same.
